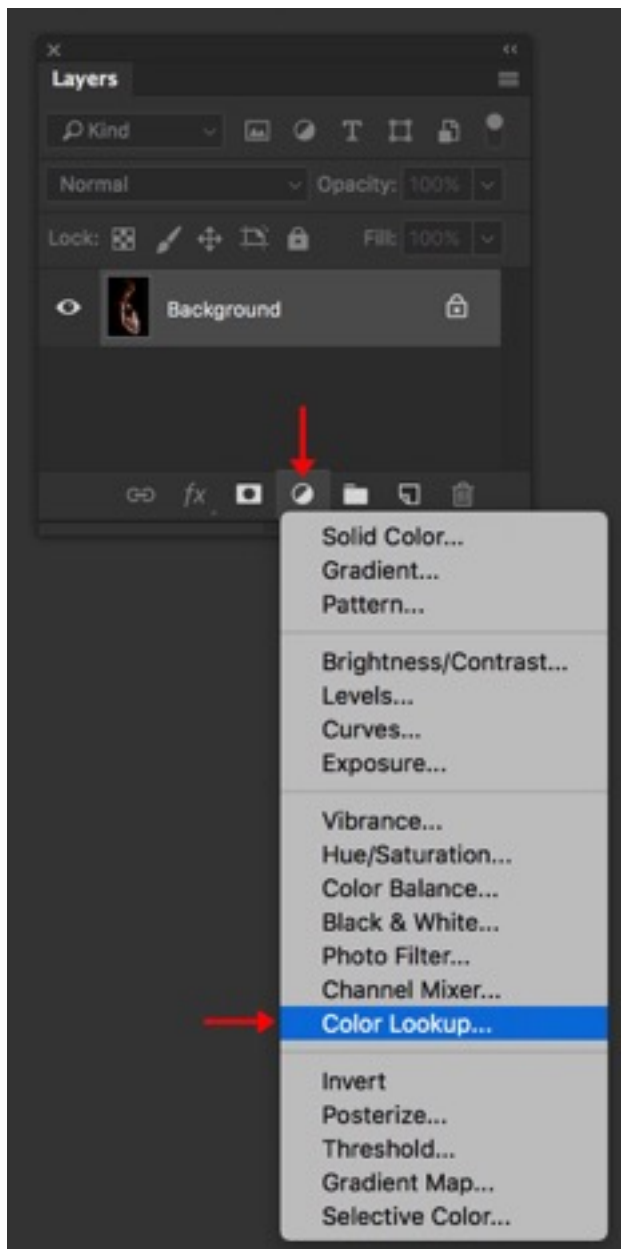

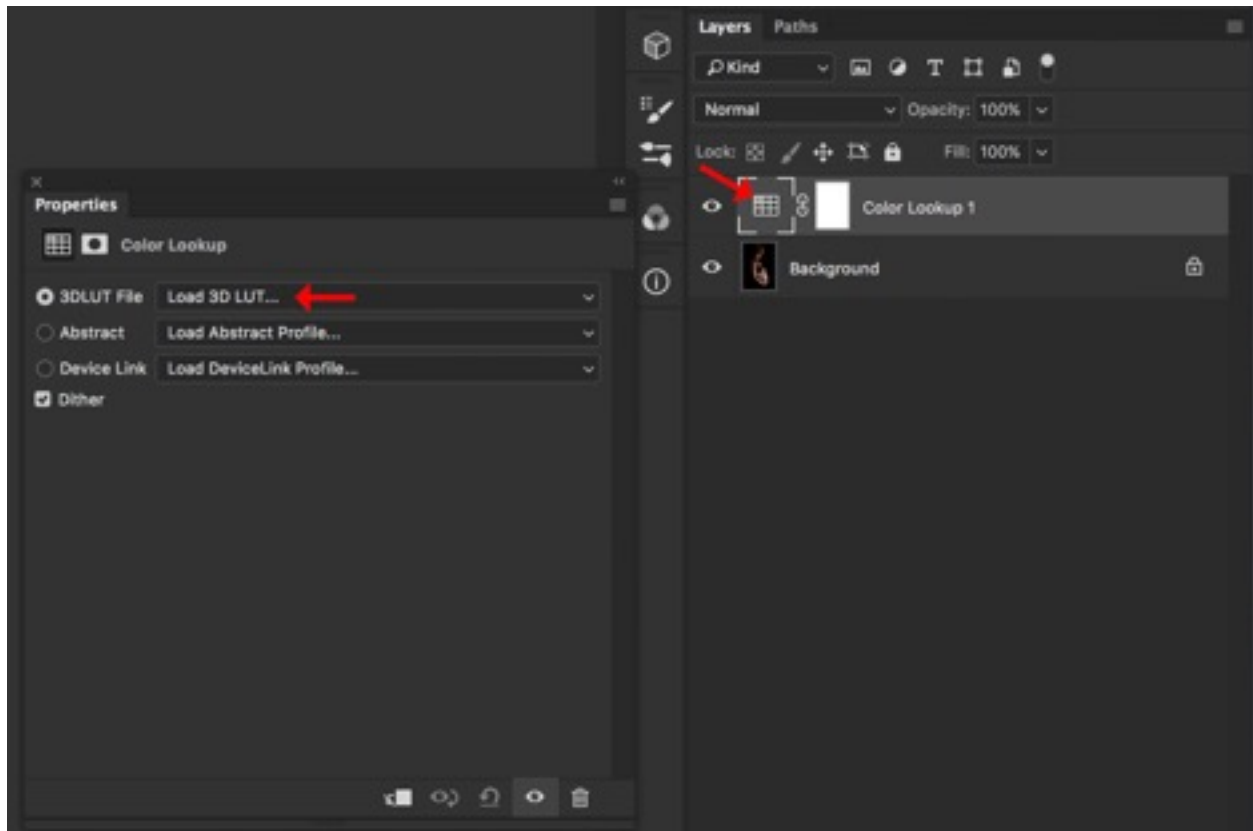
EDITING TOOLS FOR THE DIGITAL DARKROOM

Installing and using LUTs

1. Make sure your Layers panel is visible. Create a new Color Lookup Adjustment Layer. Click on the New Adjustment Layer button and choose Color Lookup.



3. Double click the Layer Thumbnail then click the “Load 3D LUT...” option to open the drop-down menu and click it once again to open a dialog box that lets you choose a 3D LUT to apply to your image.



If you'd like your 3D LUTs to show in the drop-down list of the Load 3D LUT option please follow these steps:

Mac

1. Extract the LUTs from the downloadable .zip file.
2. Select the 3D LUTs you'd like to copy. Make sure you're copying the 3D LUTs only and not dragging and dropping them in so you have a back-up
3. Copy the 3D LUTs in the following location: Applications > Adobe Photoshop CC 2015(2017, 2018, etc.) > Presets > 3DLUTs

Windows

1. Extract the LUTs from the downloadable .zip file.
2. Select the 3D LUTs you'd like to copy. Make sure you're copying the 3D LUTs only and not dragging and dropping them in so you have a back-up
3. Copy the 3D LUTs in the following location: C: > Program Files > Adobe > Adobe Photoshop (CS6 (64 Bit)) > Presets > 3DLUTs
